## Bring Items on August 28, 2023 Freshman School Supplies

Students may be asked to replenish supplies during the year as needed or to bring a few other supplies based on the specific needs of their classes. Students will also need a working printer at home as they cannot print at school.

The freshman class will participate in an executive functioning workshop during the first week of classes. This workshop may cover how to keep a neat and orderly binder system and how to use a planner. The school will provide a planner to students.

- 2 highlighters of different colors

- Two packages of college-ruled loose-leaf paper, 8 1/2" x 11" (not reinforced)

- 1" binder for math
- 1" black three-ring binder (NO "view front") w/ inside pockets – (for choir)
- Compass and protractor
- Three packages Avery (11906) 5 Big Tab Dividers with pockets (any brand with pockets, but the Avery listed is sturdiest)
- Two packages, white, 3"x5" note cards
- Wite-out (keep at home for homework assignments, no scratched-out mistakes)
- One or two sturdy locker shelves (see below)
- One journal for homilies, speakers, retreats, and seminars
- 3-5 book covers (brown paper bags or durable textbook covers)

- Three packages Avery (11906) 5 Big Tab Dividers with pockets (any brand with pockets, but the Avery listed is sturdiest)
- Two packages, white, 3" x 5" note cards
- Wite-out (keep at home for homework assignments)
- One journal for homilies, speakers, retreats, and seminars
- 3-5 book covers (brown paper bags or durable textbook covers)
- One or two sturdy locker shelves (see below)
- Students in select math classes may need 8" x 10 1/2" graph filler paper. The teacher will inform each class during the first week of school if needed.
